Jefferson Land Trust currently must rely exclusively on restricted grant or capital campaign funds to acquire lands for protection. Government grants come with many restrictions, including a land purchase cap of 10% above appraisal. Developers and other private land purchasers have no such monetary restrictions.

Even when we have grant money available, accessing those funds and completing the extensive and complex paperwork takes time. Impatient or impoverished sellers don't or can't wait when eager and well-heeled private buyers have cash in hand.

Jefferson Land Trust urgently needs a land acquisition reserve fund—an Opportunity Fund—that is immediately available when we need it. If we are to keep pace with land protection pressures and opportunities within east Jefferson County, we must have flexible access to capital. This fund will help give us that flexibility.

We are officially launching this Opportunity Fund Drive tonight as our Fund-A-Need request. We have set a goal to raise \$150,000 by the end of 2006. We have already received \$5,000 from a core group of donors to help us launch this Fund Drive. Won't you help us triple that tonight?

These things come not back: time past, the neglected opportunity, land lost.
